The high school program will be Wednesday, November 19, 2008. The doors will open at 9:30 AM for entry of the students and teachers, and the program will begin at 10:15 AM. We are asking volunteers to arrive about **8:30 AM**.

Plans are for a dinner on Tuesday, Nov. 18 before the evening presentation. Details will be communicated to all volunteers at a later time. This year's presenter will be Bob Becker of Kirkwood High School in Saint Louis Missouri. The title of the presentation will be "Chemistry Demonstrations Designed to Knock Your Sox Off!".
