



## **2010 Society for Applied Spectroscopy Local Section Undergraduate Award**

### **Call for Nominations**

The Society for Applied Spectroscopy Undergraduate Student Awardee will have demonstrated an aptitude for research in one or more of the various fields of spectroscopy and maintained a QPA of 3.0 or higher in his or her undergraduate course work. Research experience can consist of assisting a professor or a graduate student with their current research or a separately designed research project related to spectroscopy. Other factors being equal, a student who works independently or in a group of other undergraduates is preferred. Nomination materials should include 1) a copy of the student's transcript, 2) a nomination letter from the student's research mentor that outlines the results of the student's research as well as information concerning the student's over all research techniques and work habits, and 3) a written description of the research from the student nominee.

The Awardee will receive \$500, a one-year subscription to the journal, *Applied Spectroscopy*, and will be invited to the annual SSP Awards Night on May 19, 2010 at Duquesne University in Pittsburgh.
